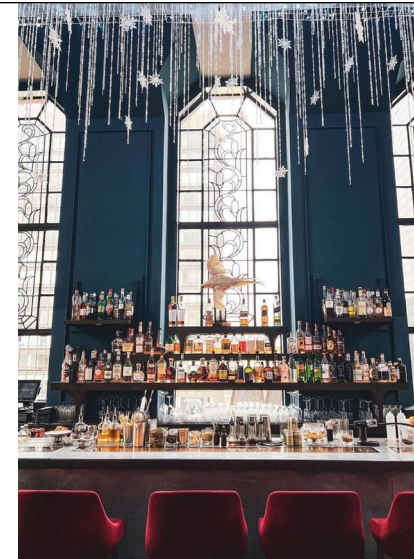
THE GRAND TERRACE
